2. Collection and processing of personal data

a) Purpose limitation

TRATON processes your personal data to send you e-mails with its Investor Relations information.

b) Data sources

As a general rule, your personal data is collected from you directly when you make your inquiry.

- c) Categories of processed data
- (Work) contact and (labor) organization details
- IT usage data

d) Legal basis

The processing activities described above are legitimate and have the following legal basis:

- consent to the processing of personal data for one or more specific purposes (point (a) of Article 6(1) of the GDPR)

3. Disclosure of personal data

In certain cases, your personal data may also be disclosed to other entities, particularly where this is necessary for sending out the Investor Relations news. We only disclose your personal data to service providers we commission based on data processing agreements. However, we will only supply the commissioned service providers with personal data that is required for them to perform the commissioned service, and they will only process said data by our order and as instructed by us. All our employees and all employees of external service providers that have access to and/or process personal data are obliged to treat said data as confidential.

4. Data storage and erasure

As a general rule, we erase or anonymize your personal data as soon as it is no longer required for the purposes outlined above and provided we are under no obligation to comply with the evidence required by law and no statutory retention periods apply to store this data for longer.

5. Your rights

In addition to the right of access to and rectification of your data, you also have a right — provided there are no statutory regulations to the contrary — to have the data erased and to object to your data being processed, and/or to limit the processing of your data. Furthermore, you have a right to data portability. Whenever we collect and process your personal data based on your consent, you also have the right to revoke the consent you have granted with effect for the future. The revocation does not affect the lawfulness of any data processing that took place on the basis of said consent prior to it being revoked.
